Plymouth Youth Hockey's Policy on Major Fighting Penalties

If a player receives a suspension for a major penalty for fighting in any league game (South Shore Conference or Yankee Conference) or tournament game then Plymouth Youth Hockey will take the following action.

- Plymouth Youth Hockey will automatically add one (1) additional game to the suspension. There would be no right of appeal for this one game suspension.
- The player would not be allowed to participate in any practices while suspended until meeting with the Grievance Committee. The Grievance Committee will determine whether or not the player would be able to resume practicing with his team while serving the suspension.
- The player would not be allowed to participate in any tournament games while serving his/her suspension.
- The Player would have to meet with Plymouth Youth Hockey's Grievance Committee. The Grievance Committee would convene a meeting as soon as practical after receiving notice of a suspension from one of the leagues.
- The purpose of the meeting would be to review all the facts surrounding the suspension in order to;
 - ☆ Determine whether additional action is warranted (I.E. player would not be allowed to participate in any practices during the suspension)
 - ☆ Answer any questions posed by either the SSC or Yankee Conference on what actions may or may not have been taken in regard to the suspension.
 - ☆ Document the suspension as required by USA Hockey and Mass Hockey.
